HALLOWEEN NIGHT IN SALEM

We cap-off the month-long Haunted Happenings with fireworks over the North River, a main stage with live music at the top of Washington Street (near the train station), and bands and DJs providing entertainment around downtown.

Thousands of people choose to celebrate Halloween night in Salem, and while we encourage people to have fun the City of Salem strongly discourages disorderly behavior, including drinking in public, littering, and random acts of vandalism. Offenders will be penalized to the maximum amount allowed under the law both civilly and criminally. Please help us maintain a fun and safe downtown environment on Halloween evening.

HERE ARE A FEW TIPS TO HELP YOU MAKE THE MOST OF HALLOWEEN IN SALEM:

SAFETY is everyone's business. If you see something say something.

IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY dial 911.

BE CONSIDERATE of private property and Salem's downtown residents.

SEEK ALTERNATE ROUTES! Take the MBTA Commuter Rail to Salem on Halloween night. Park in Lynn or Beverly and take the Commuter Rail right to Salem. Coming from Boston? Hop on the Salem Ferry from Long Wharf.

BE PATIENT. Road closures and details are numerous on October 31 (find them all on HauntedHappenings.org). If you must drive, expect delays.

ARRIVE EARLY. Plan to arrive no later than 8:30 pm so you have time to make the most of your Halloween experience in Salem.

FOLLOW PARKING SIGNS. Do not park in "Resident Parking" zones. The fine is \$40 and you may be towed.

DON'T GET STUCK. The MBTA will be closing the garage at the Commuter Rail station to cars from 8:00 pm to 1:00 am. No cars will be permitted to enter or exit the garage during these hours.

DO NOT BRING WEAPONS, FAKE OR REAL, as they will be confiscated.

PUBLIC CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL is prohibited.

TRIPLE FINES ARE IN EFFECT on October 31. This means citations for illegal behavior, including public drinking, vandalism, and littering, and could have fines up to \$300.

THE PARTY ENDS AFTER THE FIREWORKS. Plan to depart at 10:30 pm, as police and the public works department will be clearing the streets and sidewalk.
